

5 year Bible Reading plan – week 102

Week 102 - w/c 21/10/18

Monday: Mark 15:16-32. See v30 and compare Matt 26:53. The irony is that Jesus could have come off the cross by "saving himself". If He had done so, however, He could not have saved us. Praise God that he chose to die for you.

Tuesday: Leviticus 3:1-17. In this Old Testament worship which is an illustration of the reality we have in Christ, v1 reveals that in order to restore fellowship between God and us, Jesus, the perfect lamb, had to be without defect or sin and needed to be sacrificed for us. Thank God for this amazing salvation we have received.

Wednesday: 2 Samuel 17:1-29. Ahithophel realised that in rejecting his advice, Absalom's rebellion would fail. He probably regretted his involvement and saw his own future as doomed. His internal spiritual and mental struggles led him to suicide. It all started with a bad decision. Pray for wisdom in your decisions today.

Thursday: Proverbs 13:9-16. Do you take advice and accept help easily? According to v10, what does your answer tell you about how wise you are?

Friday: Jeremiah 31:1-20. The experience of every believer is summarised in v3. Thank God for his everlasting love and unfailing kindness to you.

Saturday: Ephesians 1:1-14. Our salvation is a work of God from beginning to end. Underline every reference to God in these verses ("he" or "him"). List all the references in the passage that explain what God has done in your life. Use these verses as a basis for thanksgiving and praise.
