

Week 159 – w/c 24/11/2019

Monday: Luke 21:5-38 Read v34-36 again. What is weighing your heart down at the minute? Is there anything you need to confess to God? Praise God that through the redeeming work of Jesus we don't have to go through this calamity that is coming.

Tuesday: Numbers 17:1-13 This was a case where a "small" miracle would have been convincing. God could have merely made a little green leaf sprout from Aaron's rod alone, and that would have, or should have, been enough. God gives us more than enough evidence. Do you ever have a lack of willingness to see what He has made clear?

Wednesday: 2 Kings 23:31-24:20 These verses tell of more kings that rebelled against God. They suffer defeat at the hands of the Babylonians until Judah is destroyed. Despite God's patience, generations of disobedience eventually lead to defeat. God continues to work even through this defeat. Are you rebelling against God? Turn back to God in repentance. Thank him for His continued work in your life.

Thursday: Proverbs 19:21-29 Solomon is writing these proverbs to instruct his children (v27). Attention and effort must be given to remain on the path of wisdom. James 1:5 says God will give wisdom to all who ask. Spend some time today seeking God's wisdom so that the plans in your heart are God's purpose in your life (v21).

Friday: Ezekiel 26:1-21 The judgment and fall of cities such as Tyre does not defeat God's plan; it advances it. His agenda remains the same: to establish glory in the land of the living. Pray for our nation as we prepare for the upcoming election. Pray that God's will be done.

Weekend: 2 Timothy 1:1-12 Paul is encouraging Timothy to use the gifts that God has given him. We each have gifts that God has given us through the Holy Spirit. We all lose our fire at times but these verses encourage us to fan into flame the gifts that God has given us. Pray that God will fan into flame your desire for him, that he will give you a spirit of boldness.
