

## 5 year Bible reading plan – week 70

### **Week 70 – w/c 11/3/18**

**Monday: Mark 1:40 - 2:12.** In v5 we have the first of a number of references to Jesus “seeing faith” in people. In what ways will he (and others) see your faith today? How do you expect him (and others) to respond?

**Tuesday: Exodus 11:1 - 12:20.** By making this month the first of their year, Jesus was indicating that this was a new phase of his dealings with Israel and something significant was happening. What milestones have you seen in your walk with God? Spend time in praise and thanksgiving for the “new seasons” that you have experienced.

**Wednesday: 1 Samuel 17:32-58.** Re-read verses 34-37. How did David’s past experiences and victories prepare him for his battle with Goliath? What past victories and experiences have you had that were God’s preparation for your future battles? What did you learn through those experiences?

**Thursday: Psalm 52:1-9.** Some people grow strong by destroying others. Do you know people like that? Are they like the description in this psalm, critical and speaking ill of others? Pray about how you should respond to people like this and pray for them that God will bring them to repentance.

**Friday: Jeremiah 2:1-19.** Notice verse 5. What we worship or follow becomes the standard for our life. If we follow worthless idols, like money, fame, status, or selfish desires, we become worthless like them. But if we serve Jesus only, our value in Him is very precious in God’s eyes!

**Saturday: 2 Corinthians 3:1-6.** Instead of a letter of recommendation from others to confirm our spirituality, God’s spirit writes a new code and new values upon our hearts (v3). Write down the things that have changed since you became a disciple. Give thanks to God and remember what he has accomplished. Let faith rise in you for what is still needed to make you like Jesus.
